## Respect for human dignity



At its most **basic**, the concept of human dignity is the belief that all people hold a **special value** that's tied solely to their humanity. It has nothing to do with their **class, race, gender, religion, abilities, or any other factor other than them being human.**

Human dignity: the human rights framework  
In the Universal Declaration of Human Rights article 1 states: "All human beings are born free and equal in dignity and rights." Dignity isn't something that people earn because of their class, race, or another advantage. It is something all humans are born with. Simply by being human, all people deserve respect.

### Why recognizing human dignity is so important?

Recognizing human dignity and the universality of human rights isn't just so individuals can be protected and respected. It's for the good of the entire world. If everyone's rights were respected and everyone had equal opportunities to thrive, the world would be a much happier, more peaceful place.

Instrumentalization or objectification

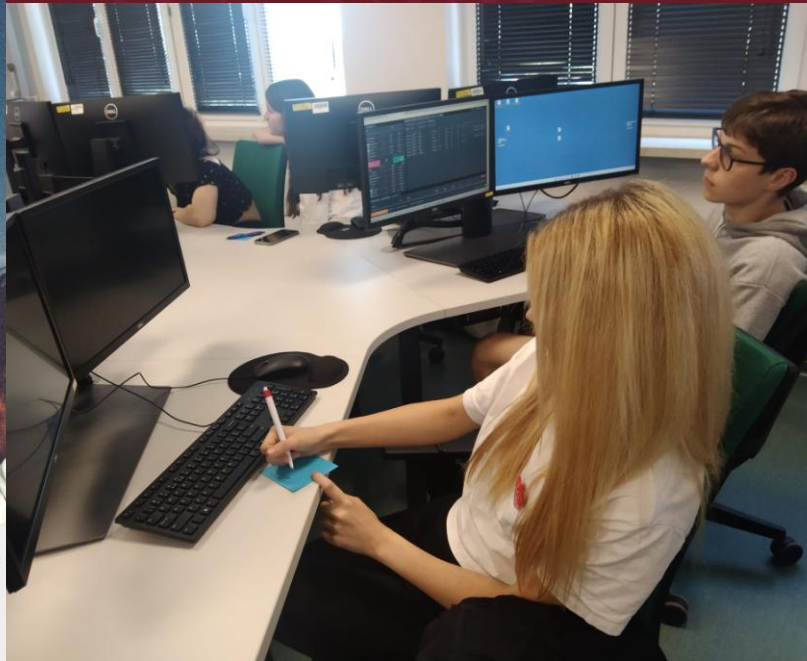
Degradation
