#### Ideas for creating videos about the violation of human rights

#### Right to say no

Sophie went to help her disabled friend Anna who wants to take things out of her locker. However, Anna refuses the help because she wants to try it herself first.

#### **Bullying on social networks**

For fun, a group of friends decide to create a fake account from where they keep sending humiliating messages to their classmate.

#### Failure to respect equal treatment

Two friends are interested in taking part on a project where they will have to represent their school. They both have the same experiences.

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But one of them is deemed unsuitable due to the community they come from/ disability.

## Right to free choice of profession

Ivan is very interested in art and wants to continue in this direction. His parents, however, do not consider such a profession suitable and they want their child to become a doctor or a lawyer.

#### The right to a clean environment

Students dislike, that people keep throwing water bottles into the school yard. They decided to speak up against this problem.
