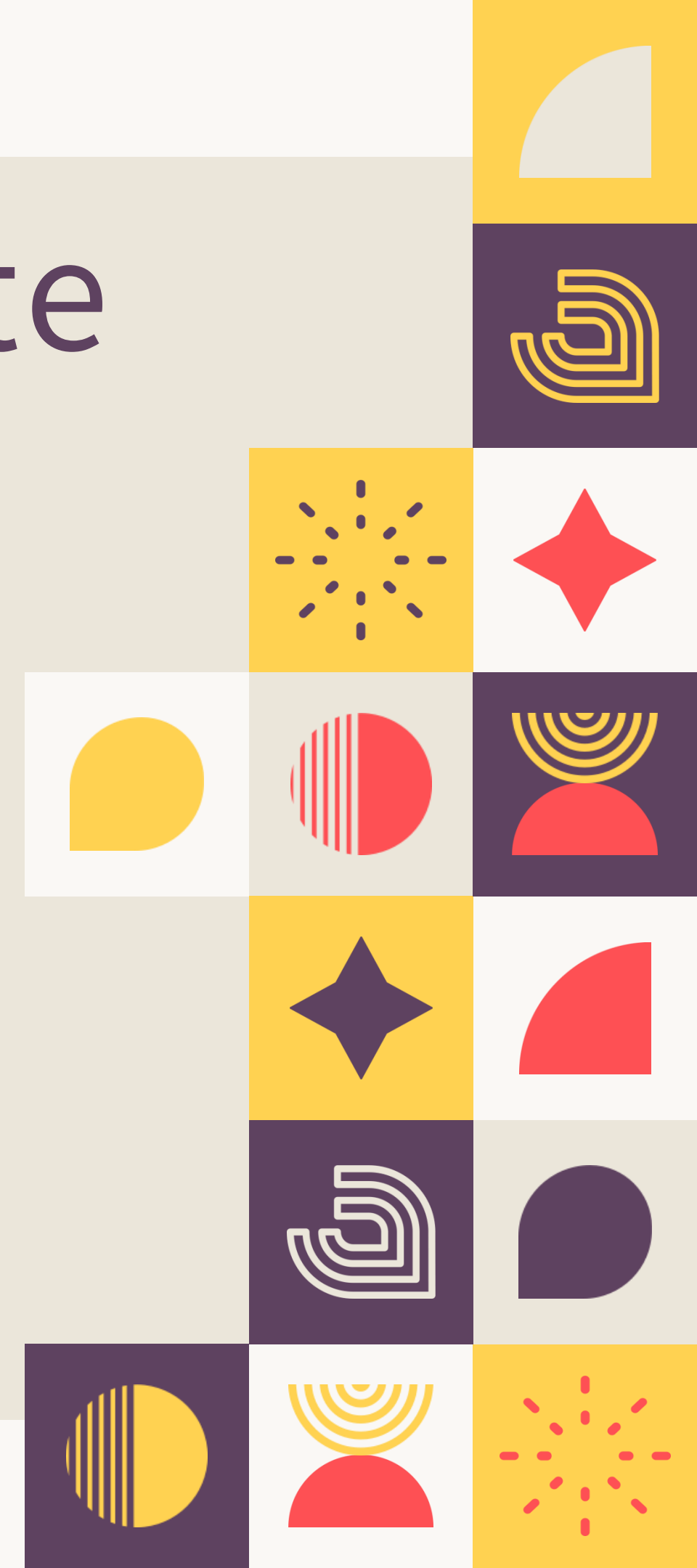

Description of the debate

- ✓ **Debate is hosted by a Moderator and takes place between two teams, the „Proposition“ and the „Opposition“.**
- ✓ **The Moderator allows the speakers to give their speeches.**
- ✓ **The Secretary controls the time.**



...

Description of the debate

➤ **Each speaker has a specific function:**

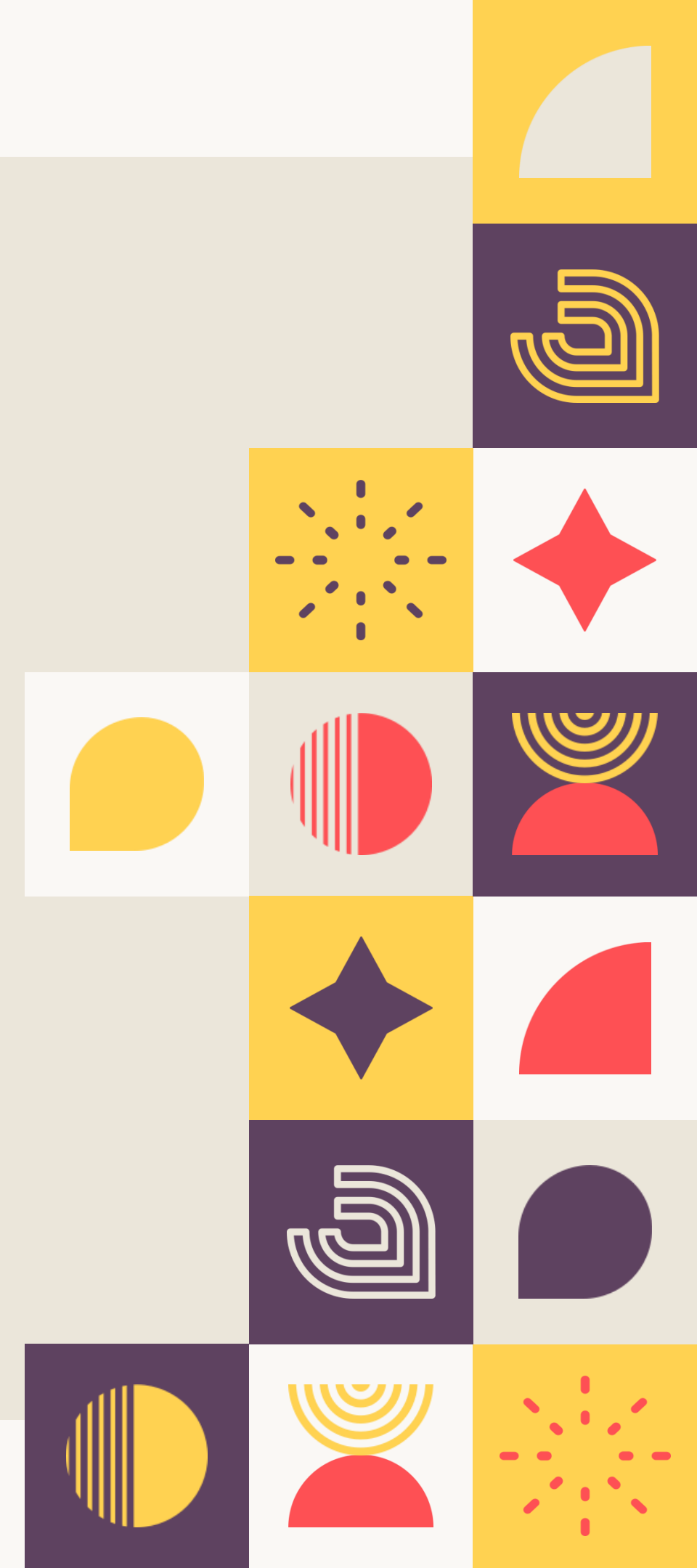
- **speaker one** outlines the topic and describes the team's understanding of the thesis,
- **speaker two** lists the arguments for his/her point
- **speaker three** responds to the arguments of the opposing side, lists counter-arguments,
- **speaker four** concludes and summarises his/her group's arguments.



...

Rules of the debate

- **Each speaker** has **3 minutes** to deliver his/her speech.
- The team has the right to address their opponents' speech with **questions** or information.
- Each speaker should **accept two questions** or two pieces of information.
- Question can be asked in the time frame indicated by the secretary.
- **At the end** of the debate, i.e. after the fourth speaker has spoken, **the public can ask questions**. The floor is given to the audience by the Moderator.
- **The decision** as to which group has **won** the debate is made by **the audience**.

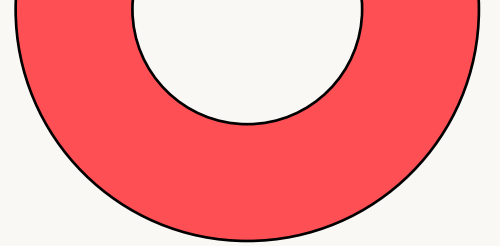

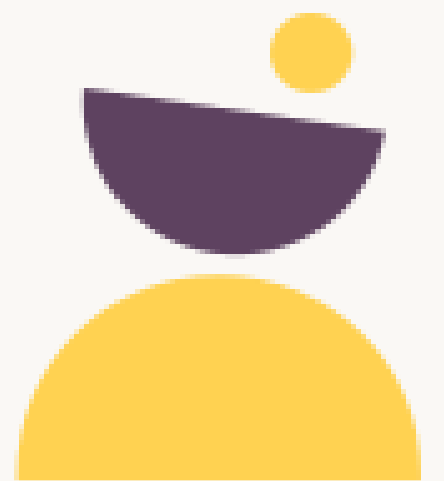
